Kansas weather is one of the hardest to predict. Games will normally **NOT** be canceled for rain. The safety of the children is our priority, so in the event that lightning is present, we will cancel games. When this happens, coaches are immediately sent a text, notification is set up on the Hotline, and the web-site is updated.

Make-up games are on Sunday of the following weekend; 3 1/2 hours later than the time you were scheduled for. If you cancel your game on your own accord, you must notify the other coach and the head coach administrator.

Because of the unpredictable weather, be sure that the players dress appropriately. They are allowed to wear jackets/sweats under their uniforms.

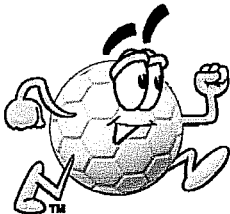

Did You Know?

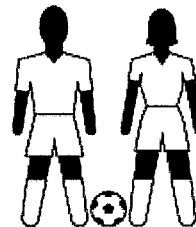
